- Hong Kong, China hosted the Joint Meeting of Expert Group of Energy Efficiency and Conservation (EGEEC 53) and Expert Group on New and Renewable Energy Technologies (EGNRET 52) during 18-22 March 2019.
- Three (3) workshops were organized on the margins of EGEEC 53:

 - APEC Workshop on Aligning Conformity Assessment Efforts for Energy Efficiency Regulations of Motors in the APEC and ASEAN Regions: 1st Stakeholders' Consultation Workshop (US)
 - APEC/NARUC Workshop on Supporting Renewable Energy Integration and Energy Efficiency through Effective Regulation (US)

- Members are requested to reach relevant Project Overseers to submit the completion reports and monitoring reports of APEC projects on time.
- Expert groups are advised to update contact lists regularly to enhance outreach to enrich membership, especially from private sectors and academia.
- EWG supports APSEC to continue its contribution to EWG for the next 5-years period.
- Members are encouraged to provide timely and high-quality data to EGEDA.



EWG 57 Summary (2)

- APEC Energy Supply and Demand Outlook 7th Edition Members are encouraged to disseminate key findings and conclusions domestically.
- **EGEEC** is advised to discuss whether ESIS will be terminated in its next EG meeting and to report the decision in the next EWG meeting.
- APERC is requested to keep monitoring and to report the progress of APEC Energy Intensity Reduction Goal.
- Members are encouraged to promote EWG-endorsed Initiative/Policy recommendation paper to their respective senior officials through domestic channel for greater visibility of EWG works in APEC high-level meeting.



EWG 57 Summary (3)

- Member are encouraged to consider volunteering to host the following EWG cooperative projects:
 - 1. Peer Review on Efficiency Power (PREP)
 - 2. Oil and Gas Security Exercise (OGSE)
 - 3. Peer Review on Low Carbon Energy Policies (PRLCE)
 - 4. Peer Review on Inefficient Fossil Fuel Subsidy
 - 5. Peer Review on Energy Efficiency (PREE) and Follow-up PREE
- EWG endorsed 5 volunteers (2 from China, 3 from APERC) to be EWG delegation to attend G20 Global Summit on Financing Energy Efficiency, Innovation and Clean Technology.
- Members are advised to provide inputs to 1st draft of APEC Energy Vision Post 2020.

• The theme of policy dialogue for EWG 58 & 59 proposed by Malaysia is Renewable Energy Transition for Sustainable Growth.
