APERC was established in Tokyo in 1996 after the Osaka APEC leaders meeting in 1995.


Primary objective is to foster a common understanding of energy challenges facing APEC member economies.

APEC Energy Demand & Supply Outlook

- The 'APEC Energy Demand and Supply Outlook' project is a priority task for APERC under the APEC Energy Action Programme adopted by leaders in 1995.
- The Outlook provides quantitative analyses and policy insights on projected trends for energy demand and supply in APEC economies through 2050.
- The 7th Edition includes three scenarios: Business as Usual (current policies); APEC Target (combines Intensity Goal with Doubling RE Goal); and 2 Degree Celsius Scenario (consistent with Paris Accord goal to limit warming to 2°C).
- Outlook results are being disseminated to each economy during Roadshow events. APERC researchers have visited three-quarters of APEC economies since the report's release. The remaining economies will be visited by the end of 2019.
- Preparation for the 8th Edition Outlook is underway. Feedback from economies on scenarios, models, and data are contributing to the development.
- The 8th Edition Outlook will utilise APEC energy data, to underpin its analysis.




Topical research in 2019



- Along with the Outlook, APERC has been conducting research on topics relevant to energy issues and policies in the APEC region.
 - Studies focusing on coal, oil and natural gas to support the Expert Group on Clean Fossil Energy (EGCFE) since 2017. The 2019 series of these three reports has already begun.
