- Canterbury Earthquake Recovery:
 - 70-80% of central city being demolished
 - 20,000 homes to be replaced
 - Significant infrastructure repair and replacement required
 - Electricity grid performed well, but repairs required.
 - NZ \$20-30 billion of damage





Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation



- Project Progress:
 - Competitive Procurement Process Completed in late 2012.
 Sapere Research Group appointed for contract.
 - Sapere are based in New Zealand, but the project team also has members in Australia and the UK.
 - Contractor is underway with work programme, with oversight from EECA and advice from the Steering Group
