- Canterbury Earthquake Recovery:
  - 70-80% of central city being demolished
  - 20,000 homes to be replaced
  - Significant infrastructure repair and replacement required
  - Electricity grid performed well, but repairs required.
  - NZ \$20-30 billion of damage

- Objectives:
  - Develop a roadmap for a "Smart City"
    - How can micro-grids help reliability, recovery, and restoration
    - Technologies recommended for deployment
    - Market system requirements
    - Regulatory needs





- Project Progress:
  - Steering Group formed with Transpower (national lines company); Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment; and the Electricity Authority
  - This group has been workshopping the project and refining the project scope further prior to procurement
  - RFP being finalized to be submitted to APEC Secretariat for approval
