



Reasons and solutions



Instead of complaints, boycotts, harmful reactions, international exchange, cooperation and win-win policy are essential:

- 1.Publicity. regular meeting, government dialogue, training, seminar, workshop, foreign visit, course or program in university, recognized certification among members;
- 2.Compatibility of standards. multiple involvement in establishment of the standards, important standards led by government or associations with strong government link;
- 3.Technical support among APEC members.
- 4.Best practices. Three level integration of supply chain in China.
