

















Manufacturing Supply Chain Centres (MSCCs) ED

 - Other SCM functions
- Regional distribution centre




- Regional Logistics Hub
- Distributes > 50 brands to markets in Asia-Pac, USA and Canada

- Europe and Western US




- · Global SCM/Procurement centre
