PREE introduction and background

- Initiated by APEC Energy Ministers in 2007 Darwin Declaration.
 - ❖ PREE: Peer Review on Energy Efficiency
- Broad review of energy efficiency policies for a volunteer economy in APEC carried out by a Review Team of experts to provide recommendations on potential improvements.
- PREE has been hosted by 11 economies:
 - Chile, New Zealand, Viet Nam, Thailand, Chinese Taipei, Peru, Malaysia, Indonesia, The Philippines, Brunei Darussalam, and Mexico.
- Follow-up PREE hosted by <u>6</u> economies:
 - Viet Nam, The Philippines, Thailand, Malaysia, Peru, Indonesia.
- PREE introduced the Energy Efficiency Policy (EEP) Workshop, which has completed 7 workshops since 2016, covering several key policy issues, such as policy and program evaluation, conformity assessment, fuel economy regulation, recovery through EE, and EE project financing, electrification & EE.





PREE 13 Project Summary

PREE Phase 13 has two parts.

The Follow-up PREE in Chile

- The Follow-up PREE is designed to assist a former PREE host economy in implementing the recommendations of the PREE review team.
- This is planned in <u>Chile</u> in the first half of 2024. (PREE in Chile was in 2009)
- The Follow-up PREE will serve as a forum for Chilean stakeholders and government institutions to assess the progress of energy efficiency policy implementation.
- A peer review report that includes expert recommendations will be presented at the following EWG meeting for the EWG member's consideration.

Energy Efficiency Policy (EEP) Workshop

- The 8th EEP will be in conjunction with an EGEE&C 63 meeting in the second half of 2024.
- The EEP Workshop will be a full-day in-person.
- The topic of EEP will be determined in consultation with EGEE&C, reflecting knowledge gaps.
- The EEP Workshop Summary Report will summarize the proceedings of the workshop and provide an in-depth analysis of the discussions
