


# 2022 Project Completion Data

# 55% female participants


second consecutive year that women outnumbered men as participants at APEC project events

Evaluates the relevance, effectiveness, sustainability and efficiency of APEC projects the year after their completion






## 2022 Longer-Term Evaluation of APEC Projects (LTEAP)

#### **Project Participants:**




rated project theme or issue as a 'top' or 'important' priority for their organisation or economy



applied learning and resources from the project in their workplace



shared the lessons, information and resources from the project with their colleagues



reported that changes in policies or practices had occurred in their economies as a result of project participation

# 2022 Longer-Term Evaluation of APEC Projects (LTEAP)

### Key results – For improvement

#### **Project Participants:**



rated the project theme or issue as being of little or no relevance to their work



reported that no changes in policies or practices had occurred as a result of their participation in the project

#### **Project Overseers:**



**delivered 'one-off intervention**' projects rather than building on previous project work.

(Projects that are delivered as a series or leverage previous work are more likely to have sustained impact)

#### **APEC PROJECT ADMINISTRATION SYSTEM (APAS)**

an online platform for the submission and assessment of APEC projects



#### **MODERNIZATION**

 The conventional way of applying for APEC funding via email is modernized through automated online processes and centralization of data



#### **EFFICIENCY**

- Data is stored and copied across forms
- Electronic notifications of next tasks are automatically received, saving user time and resources



#### **DATA ACCESS**

- Easier and faster access to project data means more timely support from the Secretariat
- More efficient extraction of data improves evaluation and analysis and supports continuous improvement of project processes


