- 3. Examine <u>current energy-saving technologies</u> for electric fans within the context of energy efficiency regulations.
- 4. Share project results, best practices, and gather <u>feedback</u> throughout the APEC region.



Workplan



- **Pre-Workshop Survey** : Reviews energy efficiency and testing standards for electric fans in Southeast Asia to guide policy.
- Workshop : One-day event with expert talks and policy sharing; results summarized in a report.
- **Final report** : Combines findings to share best practices and recommendations for improving fan efficiency across APEC.



Pre-Workshop Survey

• Policies & Management Systems :

Covers government policies on electric fan energy efficiency, including responsible agencies, standards, and labeling.

• Testing Methods :

Reviews current testing methods, alignment with IEC 60879, and future plans, including bladeless fan testing.

• Fan Motors :

Collects data on DC motor fan usage and estimates their market share.



Expected Outcome

- Participants from developing economies will <u>enhance</u> <u>energy efficiency programs</u> through a post-event evaluation to assess the workshop's benefits for these economies.
- The workshop will <u>share successful lessons in energy</u> <u>efficiency experiences</u>, improving APEC's overall energy management learning.
- Project Outputs will include :
 - 1) A Project Workshop
 - 2) A Research Report
 - 3) A Project Completion Report
